Negroes with Guns Rob Williams and Black Power

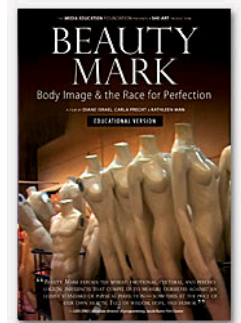
